- 7) **Summary of Program Activities and List of Credentials to be Awarded:** *DVHTE* convenes a comprehensive workforce partnership organized around an innovative employment strategy to create in-demand, skilled healthcare jobs for 176 long-term unemployed and other unemployed workers by implementing an integrated On-the-Job Training (OJT) and credentialed post-secondary education model resulting in unsubsidized full-time employment. *DVHTE* expands the work of a current H-1B-funded partnership to include newly-emerging

healthcare occupations and a Registered Apprenticeship; credentials awarded by *DVHTE* include Practical Nursing Licensure, post-Baccalaureate Healthcare Data Analytics Certificates, and Certificates of Program and/or Apprenticeship Completion for Community Health Workers. These strategies will create entry-level, middle and high-skill opportunities for the long-term unemployed to progress through all levels of career pathways necessary for achieving industry-recognized credentials that lead to middle and high skilled employment in high-demand H-1B occupations in healthcare, the Delaware Valley's largest and growing industry. *DVHTE* will match long-term unemployed workers at any point on the occupational skills continuum with career opportunities that put their abilities to the highest and best use.
