<b>Location of Grant Activities</b>	The counties of Kauai; Hawaii; Honolulu; and Maui
<b>Project Description</b>	Hawaii will build upon employer workgroups formed through its Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training grant and the Disability Employment Initiative to facilitate the development of different models of skills training and work-based learning for dislocated workers. American Job Centers have ongoing partnerships with state and county agencies, private non-profit agencies, and community based organizations that will be tapped as resources for this JD NEG, including training providers on the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL), organizations serving veterans, Goodwill, Salvation Army, Job Corps, Registered Apprenticeship sponsors, and trade unions. Additionally, the State's connection with federal workforce programs has grown through its State Energy Sector Partnership Grant; this JD NEG will be used to strengthen this interface, as well as to focus broadly on partnership development strategies. As the State Apprenticeship Agency, DLIR will use its well-established Registered Apprenticeship programs to deliver training focused on five key industry sectors. On-the-job training (OJT) will also be used as a work-based learning component of the project.

<b>Populations to be Served</b>	Dislocated workers with priority given to the long-term unemployed
